Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: What time does the retreat begin?

A1: Check-in is at 3:00pm. We recommend couples consider taking at least a ½ day off work in order to be at the hotel at check-in time to relax and enjoying the surrounding Galleria area. The retreat will not officially begin until 6pm on Friday, October 15th with dinner.

Q2: How long will the retreat last?

A2: The retreat is scheduled from 3:00-10:00pm Friday October 15th through 5:00pm, Saturday, October 16th.

Q3: What does the \$225.00 per couple retreat cost cover?

A3: The retreat cost covers a 1-night hotel stay at the Sheraton Dallas North, located near the Galleria, dinner Friday night, a full-breakfast Saturday morning, conference activities and T-Shirts for each spouse.

Q4: What about lunch on Saturday?

A4: Lunch will be on your own on Saturday afternoon. This was done as a way to allow couples another opportunity for a date, and also allowed us to reduce the overall cost of the conference. There are many restaurant options around the Galleria area, ranging from expensive to inexpensive. Lunch will be extended to allow time for travel.

Q5: What do we do if we really want to go, but cannot afford the conference fee right now or at all?

A5: Couples can reserve a spot for the conference by paying a non-refundable \$50 deposit at any time prior to September 1st. The remaining balance of \$175 is due by September 19th. There are a limited number of scholarships. You may send a note to couples@nlifefellowship.org to obtain the process for requesting a scholarship.

Q6: Is there a reduced cost for couples who can only attend one day of the retreat (Fri or Saturday)?

A6: No. Unfortunately, due to space and food limitations, we cannot provide single day registration for this retreat.

Q7: How can I pay for another couple's retreat fee?

A7: Contact us at couples@nlifefellowship.org and we will help you with that scholarship.

Q8: Can I attend this marriage retreat without my spouse?

A8: No. This retreat is planned as an opportunity for spouses to bond, grow and fellowship with other married couples.

Q9: My mate and I are planning on getting married, or we're engaged. Can we attend the marriage retreat?

A9: No. This retreat is reserved for married couples.

Q10: If my spouse and I are having serious marital issues, should we plan on attending this retreat?

A10: That is up to you and your spouse. As stated in Question 7, this retreat will be a time of rest, relaxation and fellowship with other married couples who are interested in cultivating Christ-Centered marriages.

Q11: Do I have to be a member of New Life Fellowship in order to attend?

A11: No. We welcome members and guests.

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
